In order to contain drug, anger management and domestic violence / battery offenders, there must be a coordinated community response inclusive of the criminal justice system, treatment providers, victim services, and the local community. Programs for the treatment of drug, anger management, and domestic violence / battery offenders were developed to establish minimum conditions for monitoring and containing the offender's behavior, and to provide statewide consistency in the treatment of the offender. The standards were designed to enhance victim and community safety, promote offender accountability, and provide an opportunity for offenders through treatment to eliminate violent and / or addictive behavior in all forms. Programs for the treatment of drug, anger management and domestic violence / battery offenders have been developed, to the best extent possible, so that all offenders may access the programs in the criminal justice system. CourtOrderedClasses.com was designed for these offenders to get the same benefits and access the same programs online.

Why Online Court Ordered Classes?

Often it is difficult to attend court ordered classes due to travel distances, a busy schedule, and / or other life commitments. These online courses allow you to learn the same tools as our "in-person" classes but in a low-stress, convenient, affordable and self-paced environment.

Court Ordered Classes Online Courses - How They Work

The format for our online classes are quite consistent for all our courses. We are using a treatment program created by our program director Ogan Nardos via an online platform. There are four nationally certified and approved courses that students can take: **Deferred Entry of Judgment (DEJ)** drug diversion), **Anger Management**, **Domestic Violence**, and **Battery**. CourtOrderedClasses.com provides a simple classroom reading and communicating environment, one that will allow our students to relate to and understand all course material with ease.

Deferred Entry of Judgment (DEJ)

If the defendant successfully completes his / her classes and stays out of trouble, the original charge is dismissed. The benefit to our students is a clean record and the ability to get on with his / her life free of drugs and/or alcohol.

Anger Management

CourtOrderedClasses.com is the first court approved completely online, self-paced professional program available. The benefit to our students is a clean record and the ability to get on with his / her life.

Domestic Violence

This class is a State Approved Domestic Violence Batterer Treatment Program and follows approved standards to insure quality treatment leading to the elimination of intimate partner violence and abuse.

Battery

The same State Approved Treatment Program standards as our domestic violence courses. The only court approved online program available.

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- Reading lesson text - Every lesson contains a comprehensive Adobe Acrobat (.pdf) file that students can view, fill, print and submit via email. This allows us to keep track of student attendance and course progress. Also this provides students with a permanent reference for course materials during the class and long after the class is over.
- Reading supplements - For some lessons, there will be supplemental information that will explain certain behaviors and control tools that are beyond the scope of the class. This gives a way to learn about additional control and behavior tools.
- Doing practice exercises - in some lessons, students will be asked to do practice exercises (answers provided right in the exercise) to help prepare them for the programing assignment. This is the second way that we can confirm our students understanding of the material. Students actually submit their programing assignments through email or fax.
- Final assignments - At the each course our students will be asked to complete a final assignment. Though it is not actually part of the class material, it will allow our students to assess what they have learned during the course and give feedback and ideas about the dynamics of Court Ordered Classes courses.
